

## Tips for Advising UMES Honors Students—2

### Question:

My advisee is not in the Honors Program. Should s/he be?

### Answer:

The Honors Program actively recruits 2<sup>nd</sup>—through 4<sup>th</sup>—semester\* undergraduates ambitious to lead exceptional collegiate careers.

Advisees likely to thrive in Honors are those who demonstrate:

- ◆ academic excellence (*UMES cumulative GPA of 3.5+*);
- ◆ leadership experience or potential;
- ◆ a desire to pursue research, graduate programs and professional development opportunities; *and*
- ◆ a history of community engagement that better the lives of others.

\* **Notes:** *Successful candidates for internal admission will have completed at least one and no more than three semesters (freshman/sophomore standing). Students pursuing their fourth semester and having 55 or fewer hours may still apply. While none have been established at this time, the Honors Program's strategic plan calls for the development of MoUs / articulation agreements with 2-year institutions that have Honors Programs to facilitate admission of transfer students from those programs to our own.*
